

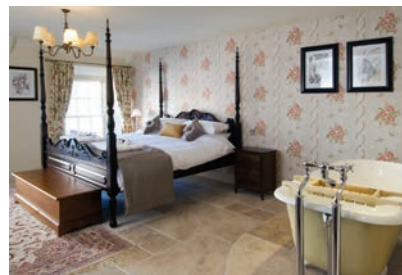
the George at Hatherleigh

A coaching inn from 1450 AD, this building served as a Courthouse, a hostel for the monks of Tavistock Abbey and was also used by highwaymen and rich wool merchants. It survived down the years to become a Grade II listed building until destroyed by fire on the 23rd of December, 2008.
